## Paul Dillon - Drug and Alcohol Research Training Australia (DARTA)

Paul Dillon has been working in the area of drug education for the past 25 years. Through his own business, DARTA, he has been contracted by many agencies and organisations to give regular updates on current drug trends within the community. He continues to work with many school communities across the country to ensure they have access to good quality information and best practice drug education.

This presentation examines what we know about the prevalence of alcohol and other drug use by school-based young people, with a particular emphasis on the latest evidence on the risks associated with teen drinking. Paul will also discuss the available evidence on the positive influence that parents can have on their child's behaviour, as well as the barriers that they may face during adolescence. Paul's talk aims to empower parents with a positive message and assist them in having open and honest family discussions in this complex area.
