If the student does not access the onsite dental van at school, they are able to be seen at some local clinics for free. All students who are enrolled into a government school can access these clinics free of charge.

Smile Squad is the Victorian Government's **free** school dental program.

This program is being led by the Department of Health and Oral Health Victoria, with input from the Department of Education. Services are currently being delivered across Victoria by local community dental agencies. The program is completely free for all Victorian government school students.

Any student enrolled in a Victorian government primary, secondary or specialist school is eligible. **They do not need a healthcare card, Medicare card or the Child Dental Benefits Schedule (CDBS).**
