NOTE:

- The College blazer must be worn to and from school and to morning Pastoral Group during Terms 2 and 3.
- While the College blazer is optional in Terms 1 and 4, students are required to wear their blazers to special events such as College Masses and Assemblies in all four terms.
- The College jumper or vest may not be worn as the outer garment when travelling to and from school.
- Students must not wear visible undergarments (eg. T-shirts).

UNIFORM CONTINUED

When students accept enrolment at Nazareth College they agree to follow all school regulations.

Students are to follow all instructions from staff regarding wearing the uniform correctly.

- Heads of House will determine whether students are adhering to uniform regulations.
- Students are required to wear their blazers to special events such as College Masses and Assemblies.
- All students must wear the correct PE uniform to Practical Physical Education classes.
- On days when students in Years 7 to 10 have practical PE classes they may wear their PE uniform to and from school.

On special occasions students may be permitted to wear casual clothes to school. On these occasions casual wear is to be **modest and appropriate**. It is inappropriate to wear singlets, short shorts, thongs or tops which do not cover the midriff or clothes which have offensive or inappropriate logos.

When casual clothes are permitted the normal rules in relation to hair, make-up and piercings still apply.

If students do not adhere to these expectations parents will be called and may be asked to bring a change of clothes to school. Alternatively, students may be sent home.

HAIR, MAKE-UP AND JEWELLERY

- Students are required to be neatly groomed at all times. Shoulder length (or longer) hair must be tied back completely with a plain hair tie or a blue or red ribbon.
- Beads in hair are not permitted.
- Boys are to be clean shaven.
- Students are not to wear make-up, nail polish or artificial nails.
- Extreme hairstyles including stark contrasts in colouring and patterns are not permitted. Heads of House will determine whether a hairstyle is appropriate.
- Students are not permitted to wear bracelets or rings of any nature. Students may wear a necklace with an appropriate religious medallion below the collar.
- Students may wear a single, small, plain, silver or gold stud or sleeper in the lobe of the ear. **No other piercings are permitted.**
- No permanent or temporary visible tattoos are permitted.

SCHOOL REGULATIONS

- If parents need to contact their child during the day they are to call Student Services.
- The school can take no responsibility for digital devices which are brought to school.
- Students may only use mobile phones with the permission of their teachers. Consequences may be issued if students make or receive phone calls or text messages during the school day. See the Digital Devices Policy.
- If students need to call their parents during the day they are to go to Student Services or their Head of House.
- Mobile phones must be kept in students' lockers during school hours.
- If students need to bring medication to school it must be left with the First Aid Officer. Asthma medication is exempt from this rule.
- Only students with a parking permit are permitted to park vehicles on school grounds.
- Smoking is not permitted on school grounds, on any school related activity or while wearing the school uniform.
- Steel rulers and liquid correction fluid are not permitted.
- Students are not permitted to chew gum at school.
- If students ride bikes to school they must be stored in the area provided.
