#### **Archbishop of Melbourne** responds to proposed amendments to mandatory reporting

'Confession doesn't place people above the law. Priests should be mandatory reporters, but in a similar way to protections to the lawyer/client relationship and protection for journalists' sources.

'For Catholics, Confession is a religious encounter of a deeply personal nature. It deserves . confidentiality.

'I urge the Government to focus on stronger protection for children, not on infringing on religious liberty.'

Having operated under mandatory reporting in other States, the Archbishop maintains his commitment to mandatory reporting to the appropriate authorities as a way to protect children and young people from abuse, while maintaining a commitment to upholding the Seal of Confession.

'The two areas are not mutually exclusive.'


