Pathway to success: Cohen's journey into Supply Chain Operations

Meet Cohen. A Year 10 student with a unique story, Cohen hadn't been attending school for about a year. But with the support of his family, school staff, and the Gre8 program, he's found an exciting new direction.

Today, Cohen toured the GDP facilities and got his first glimpse into the world of Supply Chain Operations. As he explored the warehouses, he saw real job opportunities and felt energized by the chance to learn hands-on skills. Cohen is now preparing to enroll in a Certificate II in Supply Chain Operations, setting him on a path for both academic and career growth.

Starting in 2025, Cohen will be back at school for VCE/VM Year 11, with a tailored plan that includes two days in a School-Based Apprenticeship and Traineeship (SBAT) program and one day working in the school office to boost his work-readiness.

Cohen's journey shows the power of support, adaptability, and innovative programs in helping students get back on track and build promising futures. His parents, who joined him on today's tour, couldn't be more proud of the direction he's heading.
