Introduce the characters your child will meet in the book Explore the illustrations. For example, ask: Can you point to the map? During reading Read and enjoy the book Ask your child to read out loud, tracking their finger under each word as they read Support your child if they are stuck by asking them to sound out and then blend the sounds together to read the word. When they have decoded the word, go back and re-read the sentence together. After reading Ask some of the "Questions to talk about" which can also be found at the back of each book. See if your child is able to recall some of the characters and/or key events.
