What is football Juggling?:

Football juggling is a skill that requires players to keep the ball in the air for as long as possible. Players can only use their feet, knees, thighs, chest or head to do this.

#### **Competition Rules:**

- The ball must be kept in the air using only your feet, knees, thighs, chest or head and each 'tap' counts as one point. If the ball touches the ground, wall, your arm or anything else, stop counting.

- The subject line should include your name, SPX Football Team and the number of juggles you completed in the 30 second recording.
