2023 GSG Kingfisher Fair: Trade Exhibitor Terms and Conditions

- 1. Applications: GSG families will receive preference for exhibit space, following which non-GSG family businesses will be invited to apply. Applications do not necessarily guarantee a place.
- 2. Payment: Payment of a site fee specified in Schedule 1 must be received by the School by 4 September 2023.
- 3. Display Times: 11.00am 3.00pm, Sunday 10 September 2023
- Bump in/out: Fair closes at 3.00pm Sunday 10 September 2023. Bump in Saturday 9
 September, from 10.00am to 5.00pm. Bump out from 3.30pm to 6.00pm Sunday 10
 September 2023.
- 5. Vehicle movements: all vehicles off trade sites between 10.00am and 3.00pm Sunday 10 September 2023. Parking during the day will be close by.
- 6. Camping: No camping is permitted on GSG grounds. A campsite is loccated directly opposite the school, across Nanarup Road.
- 7. Event cancellation: In the event of cancellation, exhibitors will be notified of a rescheduled event date or will be provided a refund of the site fee. Circumstances where this could happen include poor weather.
- 8. Site care: All care shall be taken by exhibitors in the care of the site. Exhibitors are responsible for any damage to sites, water pipes, electricity cables and other infrastructure. All sites must be left in the condition they are found. Rubbish bins are provided. No permanent fixtures are to be installed. Exhibitors must sell their merchandise within the boundaries of their site.
- 9. Power: Power connections are available. Exhibitors supply their own extension cords. All electrical equipment must be tested and tagged prior to the event.
- 10. Exhibitor passes: all exhibitors must enter with an exhibitors pass to gain entry. Two passes are provided per exhibitor application.
- 11. Vehicle passes: Two exhibitor vehicle passes are provided per application.
- 12. Food and alcohol onsite: All vendors must meet local government health regulations.
- 13. Official Fair Advertising: exhibitors are invited to email artwork for one high resolution pdf of advertising material to julia.bairstow@gsg.wa.edu.au This material will be displayed on the GSG website and social media platforms. Exhibitors are invited to send their 50 word advertisement to julia.bairstow@gsg.wa.edu.au for the purposes of announcement over the public address system throughout the day.
- 14. Biosecurity: Biosecurity is the responsibility of exhibitors. Contamination risks are to be reported to the Principal or Deputy Principal immediately.
- 15. Livestock: exhibitors are to meet their legal responsbilities for the identification of livestock.
- 16. Catering: Food and beverage stalls are available for the duration of the Fair outside of the Multi-Purpose Sport Complex.
- 17. By entering the Fair, exhibitors may be photographed by a GSG staff member or media personnel for publicity and/or promotional purposes. GSG and media outlets retain all rights to such material.
