School Uniform

At the beginning of Term 4 all students will transition into summer uniform. For the first two weeks of Term 4 students have a choice of wearing either full summer uniform or full winter uniform. From Monday 20th October all students need to wear the full summer uniform.

From the first day of Term 4 all students need to wear a school hat when outside. Please make sure a school hat is in your child's bag on the first day back and that it has been clearly labelled.

Please note school shoes need to be black leather shoes without branding or logos and all socks worn with the school uniform and sports uniform need to be without visible branding. We also ask that students wear minimal hair accessories that align with the school colours.

Punctuality

Please be mindful that school begins at 8.50am sharp.

It is extremely important that students arrive at school on time each day.

The school gates are open from 8.35am-8.50am. Students need to arrive at school with enough time to get into the classroom, unpack their bag and be seated in their classroom by 8.50am when lessons begin.



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Students arriving at school with time to spare have the luxury of settling in, greeting their teachers and classmates, and focusing their minds on the lessons to come. Students arriving late miss out on this natural transition period and need to catch-up on missed instructions. Arriving on time to school every day can help students develop the habit of being punctual and can help support students' learning, friendships and sense of belonging to a community.

Arriving on time helps reduce classroom interruptions and distractions for all students.
