Surf Coast Secondary College student Scarlet Menhenett is currently pursuing her passion for food as a Head Start School Based Apprentice in Commercial Cookery with Torquay restaurant Samesym.

Working with Chef Graham
Jefferies, Scarlet balances work, her
VCE VM program and Tafe –
getting a start on what may turn
out to be the beginnings of a
career in food.

Supported by SCSC, her employer, careers teachers and Head Start coordinator Nicole Smith, Scarlet has all the personal qualities needed for success – honesty, respect, resilience and passion.

Chef Graham has taken on two SBAT's in recent years. "Having an apprentice is good, because they don't have to fully leave school and can put a toe into an industry before they disengage from school and [are really] able to make an informed decision".

Scarlet hopes to finish her apprenticeship and travel – working in the food industry – learning as much as she can while gaining more experience long term. "If you love it, go for it – give it your all".

The Head Start Program is provided by the Department of Education and is available in high schools across Victoria. Coordinators for the program work with school careers teachers and students to find a School Based Apprenticeship or Traineeship (SBAT), supporting them at all stages of the process.
