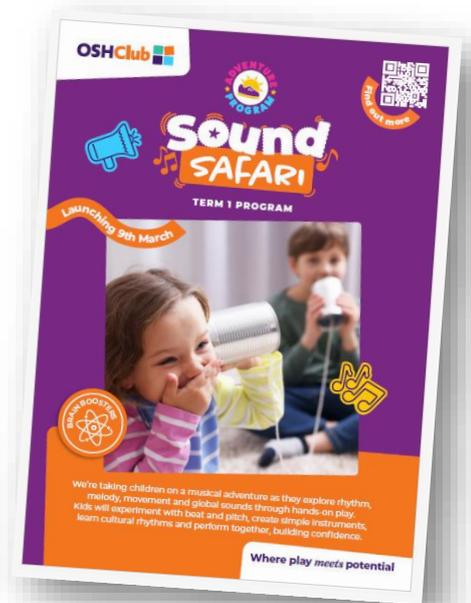

### Our Commitment to Keeping your Child Safe

### Sound Safari

During March, OSHC's program theme is Sound Safari. We're taking children on a musical adventure as they explore rhythm, melody, movement and global sounds through hands-on-play. The children will experiment with beat and pitch, create simple instruments, learn cultural rhythms and perform together, building confidence.

## Recipe

### Honey Joys

90g butter or margarine

1/3 cup sugar

1 tablespoon honey

4 cups Kellogg's® Corn Flakes

1. Preheat oven to 150°C.
2. Line 24 hole patty pan with paper cases.
3. Melt butter, sugar and honey together in a saucepan until frothy.
4. Add Kellogg's® Corn Flakes and mix well.
