## Listen up Certificate IV students, this ones for you!

This year for the first time, Year 12 students undertaking a Certificate IV and General English who are needing to sit the STAT to meet English Language Competency (ELC) requirements to secure their place at University, will be **automatically invited** by TISC to sit the STAT on the 2 or 23 of November 2019.

This automatic invitation will mean that students will no longer have to write to the University for permission to sit the STAT. It will also mean that the STAT results will be back in time for Certificate IV students to receive a December Round (Monday 23 December) offer. How exciting!

For other students, STAT invitation will occur as per the information below:

- Current Year 12's with a Certificate IV + ATAR English will get invited to sit STAT in the December and January sessions. The invitation will be programmed through TISC as part of the UAAL letter.
- Current Year 12's in less than 4 ATAR subjects (one of which is ATAR English, Literature or EALD) will get invited to sit STAT in the December and January sessions. The invitation will be programmed through TISC as part of the UAAL letter.
- Current Year 12's with 4 or more ATAR subjects (including ATAR English, Literature or EALD) will get invited as part of the UAAL.

If you're unsure what the [UAAL](#) is, it's very important you visit the link to find out as it contains your final scaled scores, ATAR (if appropriate) and eligibility information for the four public universities in Western Australia.

## Murdoch's early offer portal is now open!

Reduce that exam pressure by securing your place at Murdoch early. [Apply online](#) by 30 September 2019 and you could have your uni journey underway even before walking into your first WACE exam.

### How to apply

Back yourself and secure your early conditional offer by:

1. Making Murdoch your first TISC preference
2. Providing your year 12 mid-year report and predicted selection rank
3. Completing the early offer form by 30 September 2019 available at [www.murdoch.edu.au/early-offers](http://www.murdoch.edu.au/early-offers)

### To be eligible

To be considered, you need to:

- Meet the entry requirements for your chosen course, including minimum selection rank
- Meet English Language Competency
- Achieve your WACE

### Selection Ranks

- A **selection rank of 70** includes an unadjusted or adjusted ATAR of 70, IB score of 24, an AQF Certificate IV from a recognised training provider, or a successfully completed enabling course.
- A **selection rank of 80** includes an unadjusted or adjusted ATAR of 80, IB score of 27, or an AQF Diploma from a recognised training provider. A selection rank of 80+ is required for early offers into Engineering programs.
- A **selection rank of 90** includes an unadjusted or adjusted ATAR of 90, or an IB score of 33. A selection rank of 90+ is required for early offers into Law programs.

*Please note that Veterinary Science is excluded from the Early Offer program.*

If you're attending a [RISE school](#) or live in a [RISE postcode suburb](#), you can add 10 points to your ATAR to calculate your selection rank (capped at 90.00).
