## DIY Green House

### Materials

- Medium Sandwich Bags
- Cotton Balls
- Water
- Seeds (eg. Snow Peas)
- Green House Template
- Tape or BluTac to stick to the window

### Instructions

- Cut out your house template and write your name, the date and the seed you planted
- Stretch out and soak a couple of cotton balls in water and place one seed in
- Zip the bag shut, stick the house on and place it on the window
- Make a prediction: *How many days will it take for your seed to sprout?*
- Record your observations: *Day One: I see .... I think that is happening because...*
- When your seed has strong roots, transplant to the vegetable garden
