

ST PIUS X COLLEGE COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOLS FOR SPX VENUES

The following protocols have been put in place to ensure the safety of all players, staff and spectators attending school sport at St Pius X College.

Pre-Attendance Agreement

Please do not attend St Pius X College sports fixtures as either a player, staff or spectator if you:

- feel unwell or exhibit flu-like symptoms
- have been in contact with a known or suspected case of COVID-19
- are at a high health risk including the elderly and those with pre-existing conditions
- reside with clinically vulnerable individuals
- have recently visited various locations of identified COVID-19 clusters

Attendance

Only the following people will be permitted onsite:

- Players
- Coaches
- Faculty/Sport staff
- Match Officials
- Medical staff
- Spectators: Basketball and NSTA Tennis and ISA Cricket 1 family member per player

MWJCA Cricket - follow Community Sport Guidelines

NB. Any person aged 16 and over must be fully vaccinated or have a valid medical exemption (Medical Certificate required).

Under the current NSW Government COVID-19 restrictions, students aged 16 and older and all staff must be fully vaccinated to participate in intra-school, inter-school and community sport. They are required to show proof of vaccination status to the organiser on arrival.

Social distancing protocols must be followed, at all times, whilst on site.

Fitted Face Coverings

- The following rules and restrictions are in place regarding the wearing of fitted face coverings (ie. face masks);
- A person who is over 12 years of age must wear a fitted face covering over both their nose and mouth while in any indoor area of non-residential premises.

Removing fitted face coverings:

- A person may remove a fitted face covering if the person is engaging in strenuous physical activity, except in an indoor area as part of a gym class or dance class.
- The person must resume wearing the fitted face covering as soon as practical after the strenuous physical activity ends

Entry points

Entry points will be restricted. Please refer to the attached St Pius X College map for the access points:

- For Cricket and Basketball at Oxford Falls, entry off Dreadnought Road
- For Tennis at Love 'n' Deuce entry off Talus Street

On Arrival at venues

- All persons are asked to sanitise their hands on arrival. Sanitiser Stations are situated around the venues. Register
 using the NSW QR Code system (non students) highlighted on signage and or the School Roll (Students).
- Please have a mobile device on hand for sign in purposes (Non students).
- For those unable to use a mobile device please notify a member of the St Pius X College staff who will record your details
- Students recorded on the roll have no cause to QR Code in / out.

Facilities

- No canteen facilities will be available on site.
- Changerooms will not be available. Players will not be permitted to meet or congregate inside.
- · Water bubblers will be operational for filling of water bottles. No drinking directly from bubblers will be permitted
- Facilities will be cleaned throughout the day
- · Good hygiene practices must be adhered to while using all facilities
- First aid will be available on the site.

Player Information

We ask that players please:

- Arrive in playing uniform.
- Bring and use their own hand sanitiser
- Bring their own clearly marked drink bottle no sharing permitted, and their own food where possible
- Observe social distancing protocols where possible

Upon the completion of the sports fixture we ask that players, staff and spectators adhere to social distancing practices and move offsite immediately. Players are only permitted on site for the game they are playing in.
