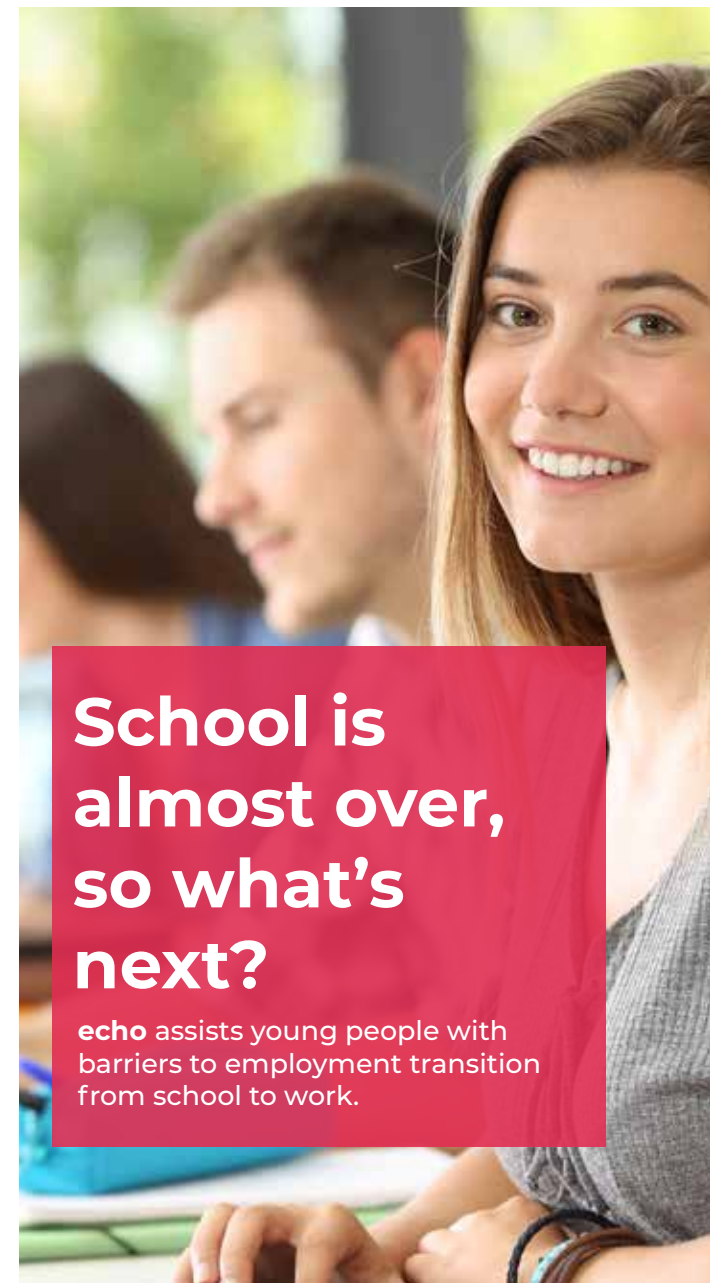

Are you about to finish school?

Many young people will experience barriers to employment such as:

- health conditions
- anxiety
- depression
- learning difficulties
- sensory difficulties
- physical difficulties

Am I eligible?

To register as an Eligible School Leaver, you must:

- Have a significant disability or medical condition
- Be in Year 11 or 12 and plan to transition from school to open employment
- Attend either:
 - a disability specialist school, or
 - a mainstream school and receive additional disability funding or be in a specialist disability class
- Not be currently employed for eight hours or more per week.
