Dental Health Services Victoria







Dental Health Services Victoria (DHSV) provides Community Dental Clinics for children 0-17 years.

It is important for children to have regular dental checks. If your child does not have a private dentist, you can access the Dental Health Services Victoria Community Dental Clinics.

Who can use this service?

- This service is available to all children 0-12 years of age
- Children in school years 7 to 12, up to 17 years of age, if they or their parents/guardians hold a current health care or pensioner concession card
- Refugees or asylum seekers.

How much does it cost?

- Treatment, examinations and check-ups are FREE for children who have a Child Dental Benefits Schedule, or whose parents hold a Healthcare or Pension Concession Card. You can check a child's eligibility online at www.humansevices.gov.au or by phoning 13 20 11. If you qualify, your children are eligible for \$1000 dental care over 2 calendar years
- For children 0-12 years that do not fit the above criteria, there **may** be a cost of \$34.00 per course of care. Please check with your Community Health Centre Dental Clinic on the numbers below.

What type of treatment is provided?

Community Dental Clinics offer care to all children every one to two years. After your child's first course of care is completed you will be sent a letter of offer for further treatment in two years. Children who are assessed as high risk are seen every 12 months.

All general dental treatment is provided including:

- Dental check-ups and advice
- Dental sealants to prevent decay
- Teeth cleaning

- Fillings
- Extractions
- X-rays

Who provides the treatment?

- General treatment is provided by dental therapists
- More complex care is performed by dentists
- Specialist dental care is not provided but referral to a dental specialist and can be arranged by Dental Health Services Victoria if required.

Where will the care be provided?
