

# ROFFEY FAMILY VOLUNTEERISM AWARD

The Roffey Family Volunteerism Award recognises and honours a student's significant contribution to the local community through their activity and participation as a volunteer.

Volunteering is defined as an activity which takes place through a recognised community organisation and is undertaken:

- outside of school hours and must include duties not associated with school
- over a reasonable period of service/number of hours, **within the current school year**
- to be of demonstrated benefit to the local community
- for no reward or financial gain
- freely and of the student's own volition
- to be an inspiration for others

A student who receives any reward or financial benefit for their volunteer work is ineligible for this award.

Note: Reward or benefit does not include trophies, medals, certificates or other forms of acknowledgment of achievement the student may have received from a community organisation.

## Award

The award is:

- To recognise and acknowledge the volunteer contribution a student individual has contributed to their community.
- To celebrate and support the work of the student volunteer
- To inspire students to start volunteering or volunteer more

## Eligibility

Nominees must include volunteering which fits within the definition of volunteering as outlined above.

## Conditions

- All nominations must be on the official nomination form, with a separate form for each nomination
- Nominations must be received directly from the community organisation or its representative
- Nominations will not be accepted from College staff or relatives of the student.
- All nomination material submitted remains the property of Cheltenham Secondary College
- Nomination forms must be completed in full
- The nominating person must sign the completed form prior to lodging and must be contactable to confirm their nomination
- Nominations must be received by the Nomination Closing Date; **Friday 17th November 2023**

## Selection Procedure

A panel will be selected by Cheltenham Secondary College to consider all nominations. Selection of panel members will be as deemed by the College Principal Staff. Once all nominations have been considered, a winner will be selected and invited to attend Presentation Night to receive the award.

The decision of the panel is final and no correspondence will be entered into. Unsuccessful nominees are encouraged to continue volunteering and are not precluded from being nominated in successive years.
