
2022 Kingston Youth Awards

Eligibility

To be eligible for an Award, nominated individuals must be Australian citizens who either live, work or study within the City of Kingston. Nominees should have made a noteworthy contribution during the current year and/or given outstanding service to the local community over a number of years. Nominees for the Youth Awards must be 25 years of age or younger.

Individuals cannot self-nominate and can only be nominated in one category. Community groups must be not-for-profit organisations, operating with the City of Kingston and must consist of four members or more. Previous Award winners are ineligible to win an Award in the same category again.

Assessment Criteria

In choosing the recipients of the City of Kingston Youth Awards, nominees are assessed with regard given to:

- Demonstrated impact, contribution and commitment to community;
- Demonstrated dedication to their passion, idea, and / or cause;
- Personal attributes of the nominee/s, such as being an inspirational and positive role model for their peers, leadership, innovation and / or creativity;
- Community groups must demonstrate that they meet an identified community need or priority

Nomination Categories

The nomination category will be for the City of Kingston Youth Awards

Selection Process

Once nominations have closed, the selection panel will consider all eligible entries against the assessment criteria and select a winner. The selection panel consists of the Mayor and fellow Councillors of the City of Kingston.
