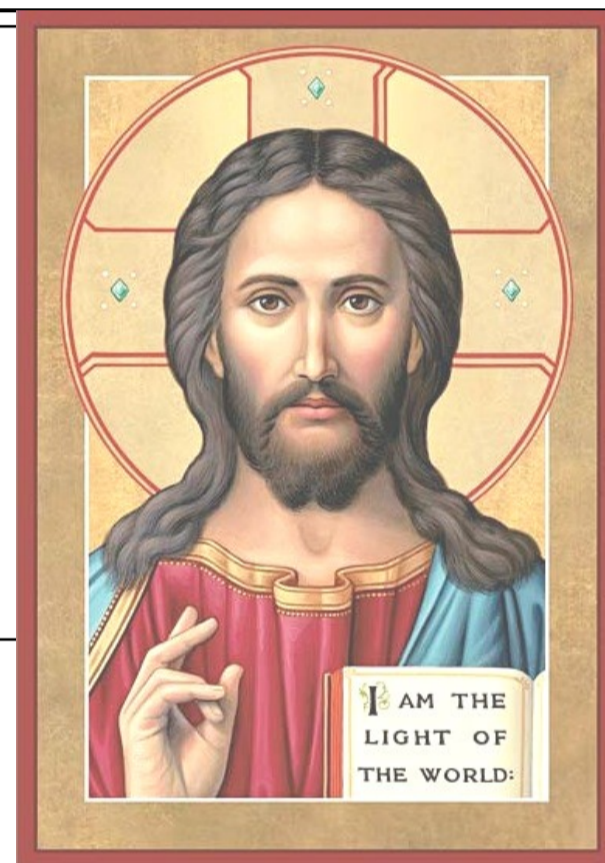

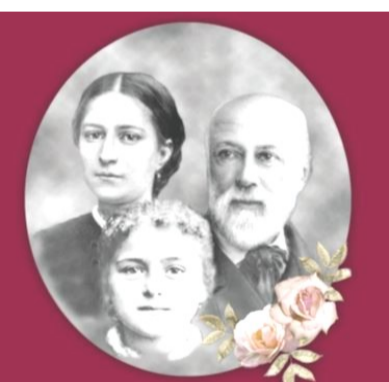

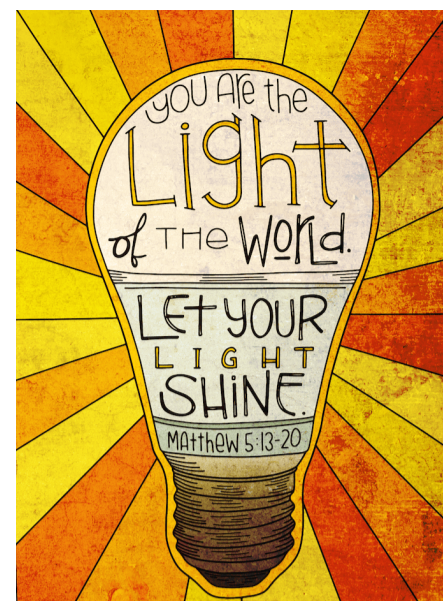
**Gospel Acclamation:** *Alleluia, alleluia! I am the light of the world, says the Lord; the man who follows me will have the light of life.*
