YOTY Chairs: Fill in your details on page 7 and email the form to your entrants.

When you get the completed forms back prepare the forms for the judges by either-

- saving a version which does not include the entrant's personal details, or
- print the form's pages from 3 to 7 and deliver to your judges.

Entrants: Fill in the form and email the completed form to your parent/guardian.

Parent/Guardian: Give your consent by filling in the relevant fields and checking the boxes as confirmation. Email the form to the School delegate.

School: Email the completed form back to the club YOTY Chairperson as your confirmation that all the academic claims made by the student are correct to the best of your knowledge.

YOTY Chairs: Remember to send the ORIGINAL FORM (with all details) of the winner/s on to the next level with the appropriate Winner Advisory Forms.

There is no need to physically sign this form at any stage.

This form is a type-able document & only available from your Club Chairperson, your District Coordinator or State Coordinator.

How can you benefit?

'Lions Youth of the Year' ('YOTY') Program was established more than 50 years ago with the objective of developing and honing participants' skills associated with interview technique, personal interaction, networking, public speaking and 'thinking-on-your-feet'.

As you leave school and enter employment or further education such skills will be invaluable tools in establishing your career path on a positive trajectory.

The Entry Form seeks data for an interview, which all entrants undergo as an initial step.

Can I enter? Am I eligible? You are encouraged to enter the YOTY program if you:

- 1. are attending (or have attended) a high school or other secondary educational establishments including correspondence schools and technical colleges in Australia during the Lions year (1st July 30th June) or part thereof;
- 2. are a citizen of Australia, PNG, Norfolk Island or a permanent resident of Australia.
- 3. attain the age of 15 and be under the age of 19 years as at, or by, 30th June of the year of the national final of the Program. You must enter the program with only one club. Previous State winners are ineligible.

The evaluation process.

'The 'YOTY' program is conducted over a series of 'finals' commencing at your host club level, leading to Zone, Regional, District, State and National where the procedure at each of these events is for entrants to participate in an interview and public speaking events at which a speech of five minutes' duration and responses to two impromptu questions are required. The highest scoring entrant in a final is invited to proceed to a following final.

A panel of independent judges will evaluate you at each of the above finals. It is important to note that the judges are not members of an organization associated with an entrant in any way, however a Lions member may be a judge. (Please see the Guide for full details)

Their evaluation will be conducted in accordance with the following criteria: (A total of 100 points is possible).

Filling in your Entry Form.

This form is all about you and what you would like the judges to know about you as a person, a leader within your school and community and your aims, goals and achievements. *It is about your strengths, not your weaknesses.*

The sections throughout the form are suggested fields for you to fill in but they are not definitive and you won't be judged negatively if fields are left blank. For example: You may not play sport and have no interest in sport, but you are in the School Band and sing in your local church choir. Make sure you highlight those activities in the 'Cultural' field.

You do not have to go into great depth on the form. Just dot point the things you would like to talk about with the judges. It is better to have too much information than not enough, but be aware- the fields are text limited because the judges, like you, are busy people and they may have 6 or 7 applications to read through before your interview.

Filling in this form may be the best thing you've done for yourself to date. Enjoy the experience. You are already a winner!

Students may submit an updated Entry Form at any stage of the program, up to and including the State Final. Revised Entry Forms must be endorsed by the contestant's school and sponsoring Lions Club. The revised Entry Form must be submitted to the relevant YOTY Chairperson at least seven days prior to the conduct of that Youth of the Year final.
