Agricultural scholarships available for 2023 include:

- GRDC (Grains Research & Development Corporation) Agricultural Training Award Scholarships (4 scholarships valued at \$3000 each): Recipients will be interested in pursuing a career in the grains industry.
- **2. WA Farmers Agriculture Ambassador Scholarship:** \$500, a complimentary annual membership to AgConnect and a complimentary ticket to attend all AgConnect events.
- 3. Wool Education Trust Scholarships (3 scholarships valued at \$3000 each): Recipients will show outstanding potential and a particular interest in the wool industry.
- **4.** Old Collegians Association (Inc) Scholarship (\$500): The recipient is expected to be a reasonable achiever and should demonstrate the potential to be involved in an accepted career in agriculture.
- **5.** College Farm Scholarship (\$500): The recipient is expected to be a reasonable achiever and should demonstrate the potential to be involved in an accepted career in agriculture.
