Agricultural scholarships available for 2023 include:

1. **GRDC (Grains Research & Development Corporation) Agricultural Training Award Scholarships (4 scholarships valued at \$3000 each):** Recipients will be interested in pursuing a career in the grains industry.
2. **WA Farmers Agriculture Ambassador Scholarship:** \$500, a complimentary annual membership to AgConnect and a complimentary ticket to attend all AgConnect events.
3. **Wool Education Trust Scholarships (3 scholarships valued at \$3000 each):** Recipients will show outstanding potential and a particular interest in the wool industry.
4. **Old Collegians Association (Inc) Scholarship (\$500):** The recipient is expected to be a reasonable achiever and should demonstrate the potential to be involved in an accepted career in agriculture.
5. **College Farm Scholarship (\$500):** The recipient is expected to be a reasonable achiever and should demonstrate the potential to be involved in an accepted career in agriculture.
