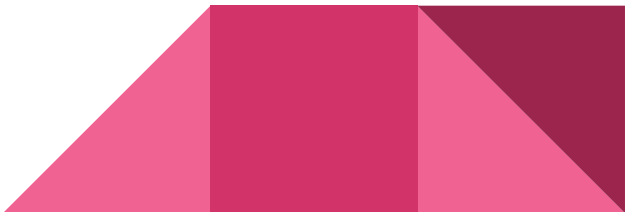
What is a Chromebook?

- *Web based device*
- *Little - no internal storage*
- *Tablet x Laptop*
- *Runs on Google Chrome OS*
- *Designed to be used primarily while connected to the Internet, with most applications and documents living in the cloud*



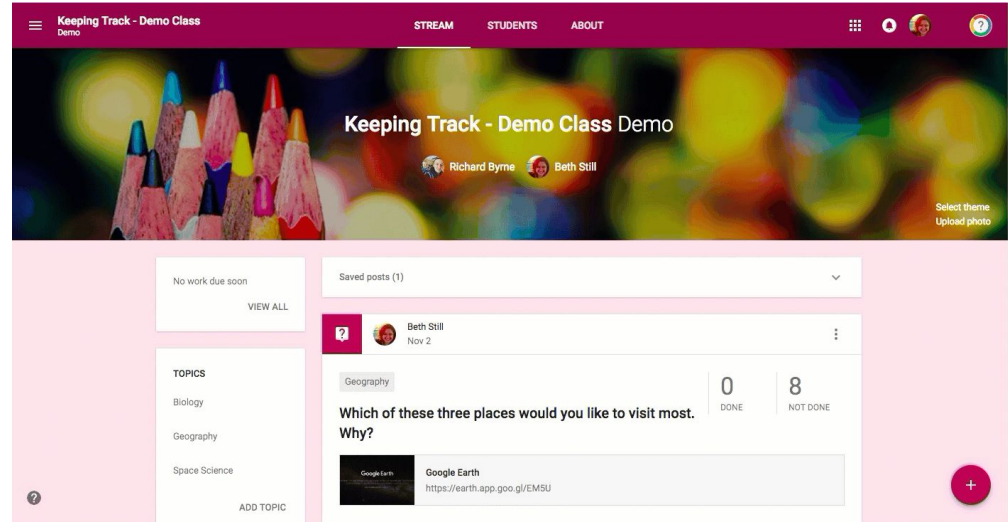


Benefits of a Chromebook

- *More cost effective - less than an iPads*
 - *In-built virus protection*
 - *Updates itself to the latest version - no need for manual downloads or upgrades*
 - *Long battery life*
 - *No software required - log in with Google account*
 - *No internal storage - no long load times for starting up or updating software*
 - *Won't be made redundant by new operating systems*
 - *Can work online or offline*

BYOC Program Guidelines

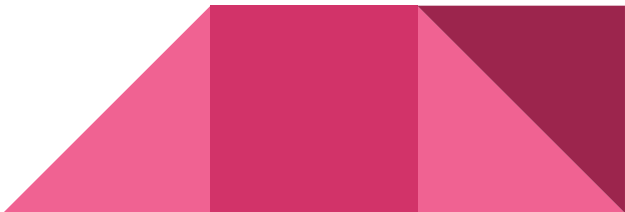
All students and parents/guardians sign:

- ➔ *BYOC Code of Conduct*
- ➔ *Acceptable Use Agreement*
- ➔ *Digital Media Consent*



BYOC Code of Conduct - Expectations

Students are expected to:

- *Use their device in an appropriate and educational manner that works in accordance with the Acceptable Use Agreement*
 - *Not loan their device to another student or leave it unattended in such a place that is likely to be easily stolen or damaged*
 - *Use age appropriate and educational apps and games*
 - *View age appropriate content*
 - *Have no social media accounts or apps installed on the device at school*
 - *Follow all teacher directions, including when to use the device*
 - *Only use the device when under supervision of a teacher during class time*

BYOC Code of Conduct - Expectations

I understand that if I breach this agreement, I will be suspended from the BYOC program for a period of time deemed appropriate by the school, whereby my device will be removed from me. In addition, it is my responsibility to report and where appropriate, remind my peers of the commitment made to the School when signing this BYOC of Conduct and agreement. I also understand I must work within the Acceptable Use of Internet Agreement.



Home Expectations

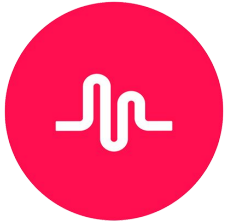
- Sign a home contract

Online Predators - Unwanted Contact

- ➔ To help minimise your child's vulnerability to unwanted contact online, encourage your child to:
- Raise any concerns or worries with you or another trusted adult
 - Use only a first name or nickname to identify themselves online
 - Never disclose private information such as their address or phone number
 - Never send photographs of themselves that clearly show their identity
 - Never agree to meet someone they have met online
 - Only use their device under supervision
