- Recognise and choose appropriate units of measurement of volume, mass, and capacity
- Recognise the significance of the prefixes in units of measurements
- Convert between common units of measurement
- Revise efficient mental and written strategies to solve problems

Religious Education

- Explore 'Preferential Option for The Poor' and how those most in need in our community deserve our greatest attention
- Discuss the disparity in opportunity between the wealthy and the poor

Inquiry/P.B.L (Problem Based Learning)

- Engage with business experts to learn more about the functions and requirements of a specific business
- Develop and present an engaging idea for a business model
- Identify suitable businesses and explore employment opportunities
