### Semester One Examinations – Year Ten

The Year Ten Examinations commence on Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> June and students are only required to be in attendance at the College for their scheduled examinations. As there are two exams scheduled on this day, any student that has indicated their preference to remain at the College between examinations, will attend a (supervised) private study in Period 3 and 4 on this day. If a student is unable to attend an examination due to illness or injury, the parent/guardian/carer must inform the College as early as possible, and a medical certificate must be provided upon return to the College.

At the discretion of the Subject Teacher and/or the Head of Learning, a student may be allowed to complete a scheduled 'Catch-up' Examination, and this will be determined on the merits of the individual request and may also be referred to the Deputy Principal as required.

### **College Expectations – Year Ten**

- 1. Students should arrive to the College <u>twenty minutes prior</u> to the commencement of the examination and are not required to attend Homeroom prior to their examination.
- 2. All bags, mobile phones, smart watches and other devices must remain in the student's locker.
- 3. Students that have special provisions for the examinations must place their Purple Card on the desk in the examination venue or make contact with the Coordinator of Learning Support at least 24 hours prior to the examination.
- 4. Please check and ensure that you bring all required/permissible materials to your examinations.
- 5. Students are allowed to provide a water bottle with all labels/markings removed to a maximum volume of 750ml.
- 6. Students are permitted to use the toilet only after 45 minutes and not in the final 30 minutes. (Students with specific medical provisions may be exempted)
