Dear Parents/ Carers and Students,

Our first Progress Checks for 2021 Headstart will be released after 2:30 pm on Friday 18 December.

It is the start of a new academic year! This year, we saw the implementation of frequent progress checks released to families approximately every five weeks. Feedback from parents and carers show there is high satisfaction with the frequency of progress checks. Therefore, we will continue with this method for 2021, starting with letting students and their families know how they have performed during Headstart.

In addition to the increased frequency of progress checks, we have also created a new Learning Behaviours rubric which aligns with our School Values and includes Learning Growth, as requested via the Parent Feedback Survey conducted earlier this year. This new rubric uses positive language that students can understand and replicate. Please take the time to read through this rubric with your child/ren and discuss how they can continue to perform at their personal best in classes for 2021.

Together with Learning Behaviours, this progress check will provide you with information about your child's Attendance and Academic Performance. At Mordialloc College, we want students to attend at least 90 % of their Semester classes. You will be able to track this over the several progress checks conducted during the semester. Academic Performance relates to the amount of work being completed and the level at which your child is performing.

Following this information letter is a copy of the Learning Behaviours rubric as well as the ratings used for Attendance and Academic Performance. Please note, that for this progress check, Learning Growth was not completed due to only three weeks of lessons being conducted, which is too short a time to realistically measure how much learning growth has occurred.

To access Progress Check results, log into your Compass Portal and you will see the link from your dashboard. If you want to use your mobile app, you will need to open the **web browser**.

To access these results via the browser:

- From the Home Screen, click on the 'View Academic Reports' item
- A list of Academic Reports will be displayed
- Select **2021 Headstart Progress Check** from the drop down Cycle box at the bottom of the Progress Reports section.

Attendance

As Headstart has been for a period of three weeks, it is important that students attend every lesson to ensure at least 90 % attendance is achieved. If a student has **missed more than one lesson** in the past three weeks, the teacher has indicated that their attendance needs attention.
