We will schedule a lunch break and a dinner break and we ask all students for their patience as this is a long and technical process. Each school group will need at least 1 teacher with them for the day.

While act 1 is being teched/plotted, all Act 2 performers can either be in the auditorium, outside in their groups or quietly backstage. We would like all performers there for the whole day so bring everything you need for the evening, in the morning. You will have notification soon as to where your performance sits in the schedule.
