

Become a Class Rep

What is a Class Rep?

A class rep (class representative) is a parent who liaises with the teacher on behalf of other parents in the class. It is not a very time-consuming role!

What are the tasks?

Some of the tasks of a class rep include:

- Liaising with the Fundraising Team and Carnival Committee on behalf of the class and encouraging others to be involved in fundraising events
- Assisting the classroom teacher to organise extra helpers at times (e.g. for Grades 3 and 4, extra volunteers for the Stephanie Alexander Kitchen Garden program)
- Being the class contact person for special events (e.g. Grade 6 graduation)
- Welcoming new families to the school
- Organising support for families in the class where appropriate

Extra responsibilities that some class reps have taken on (but are totally optional) include:

- Organising morning teas for new families
- Organising social events for families

Social activities must be coordinated by the class rep and go through the school office.

How Many are Needed?

Prep teachers would like **two** class reps per grade

Year One teachers would like **one or two** class reps each

Year Two—Six teachers would like **one** class rep per class
