

2023 SSBI Family Application Form

The Australian Government has established the **School Student Broadband Initiative (SSBI)** to provide free home internet for one year for families with school aged students in the Northern Territory.

This form allows families to nominate themselves for the SSBI. Eligible families will be provided with a voucher to use with a participating Internet Service Provider.

Eligible families must:

- have a child living at home that is enrolled in an Australian school in 2023
- not have an active NBN internet service at home. Having a mobile internet service does not affect eligibility
- live in a premises that can access the NBN via a standard connection. This will be validated by NBN Co.

The SSBI is unavailable on NT Island Communities.
