NATIONALLY CONSISTENT COLLECTION OF DATA (NCCD)

The NCCD allows schools to list students for whom have a disability and for whom they are making adjustments for in their learning programs. The NCCD is to assist the government to know how many students in a school are being offered additional support to improve their learning, from extensive adjustments such as having a 1:1 Learning Support Officer to having a supplementary adjustment such as a small and highly structured literacy support or Essential Mathematics class. This funding method means more students who have in the past missed out on the opportunity to receive support can be considered. The NCCD Team have been working hard to ensure all students receiving adjustments to their learning program will be supported in 2020.
