Literacy & Numeracy Update

Students have been developing skills to hear, say and read the following sounds in decoding activities.

/s/ /a/ /t/ /p/ /i/ /n/ /m/ /d/

We have also had a focus on identifying letter names and will be focusing on the letters that have their sound at the start of their name this week. These include:

Bb Tt Vv Pp Zz Dd Jj and Kk.

In Numeracy, students are exploring numbers 1-5 and the various ways to represent these numbers. For example, 5 is 4 and 1 OR 3 and 2.



Skill in Focus: Articulation

Here at school we have a strong focus on teaching students how to articulate a range of consonant and vowel sounds. This involves exploring what our mouths look like when we create a sound and using cued articulation gestures to help prompt students to produce sounds.

Students may be able to share some of these gestures with you at home!



Upcoming Learning

Students are continuing to learn about 'Families'. They will have the opportunity to present a picture or drawing of their family to the class later in the term. Conversations at home around family members and names used to describe people in their own family is encouraged to help support students confidence in this task.
