



# 2023 NEW COURSE DIPLOMA OF NURSING YEAR 12 STUDENTS

## Early Start - Diploma of Nursing (Partial Completion)

Designed for students who know their career goals and are seeking a Diploma of Nursing (HLT54121), this innovative, five-day program is due to commence 2023 with select enrolments opening in August 2022.

This course allows you to complete the first year of the Diploma during 2023 whilst completing your last year of senior secondary schooling. Our early entry Nursing students will study three days of core classes at Swinburne's Croydon campus and undertake the practical requirements of the course at Swinburne's Wantirna campus two days a week using the nursing simulation labs.

Students who successfully complete the first year will then be eligible for direct entry to complete the final year of the Diploma at Swinburne's Wantirna campus.

Students who choose to exit at the conclusion of year 1 will be issued with a Statement of Attainment listing the completed units.

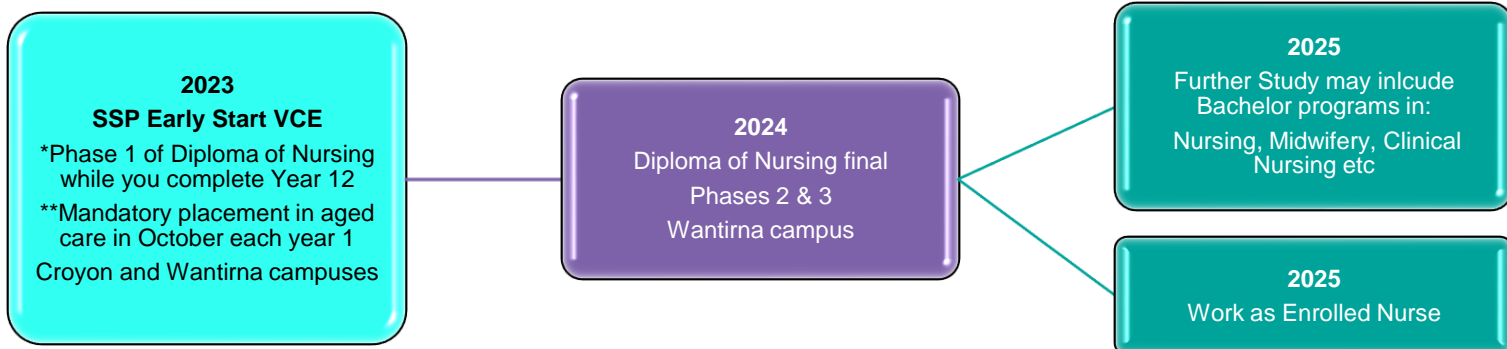

# ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants must be 18 years of age by the 1<sup>st</sup> October 2022
- Achieve a level 4 minimum and above in reading and writing and mathematics. (This testing will be conducted via the Swinburne BKSB system).
- Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia (NMBA) specified level of English Language test.
- Up to date immunisations for:
  - COVID19 Vaccination – full course (2 doses) required to commence the program, the booster dose is required prior to clinical placement.
  - Measles, Mumps, Rubella
  - Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis (Whooping Cough)
  - Varicella (Chickenpox)
  - Hepatitis B
  - Influenza (Annual requirement)
  - Tuberculosis Screening – QuantiFERON Gold test
- Working with Children Check (Volunteer or Employee) for the duration of the program
- NDIS Worker Screening Check – This process includes a National Police Check

**FEES-** The Diploma of Nursing is a [Free TAFE for Priority Courses](#), available if you are under 20 years old, or enrolling in a course at a higher level than you have completed before. VCE subjects-students must be eligible for Skills First Funding on application.

**PROFESSIONAL RECOGNITION** - Swinburne's diploma of nursing (HLT54121) is accredited by the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Accreditation Council (ANMAC). accreditation with ANMAC means the program of study meets the required education standards for enrolled nurses. The course also has the approval of the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia (NMBA). The NMBA is responsible for the regulation of nurses and midwives. Approved programs of study are listed on the NMBA website. On successful completion of this course, you may apply for registration as an enrolled nurse with the NMBA. This registration is managed through the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA).
