

Our Term at a Glance

### Literacy

In Reading and Writing we continue narratives from week 1 to 4 before moving into procedural texts for week 5 to week 8 and finishing the term with s short unit on reviews from week 9 to week 10.

In relation to these three text types students will continue to develop their knowledge of making connections, inferencing, searching for and using information and critiqing pieces.

### Numeracy

In numeracy the year fives will continue exploring measurement from week 1 to 6, delving deeper into length, mass and capacity, along with time and angles.

In weeks 7 to 10, students will be learning about shapes and their space as well as location, developing their ability to use and create maps.

### Inquiry

In inquiry we will be diving into the world of science through our unit 'The Journey to Discovery'. Throughout this unit we will investigate the scale of the solar system, light refraction, electrical currents, states of matter and coding.

The fives will have an excursion to Science works and an incursion visit from Mad About Science during the term.

In Respectful Relationships, the five's will begin by exploring and developing help seeking skills before moving on to the topic of gender and identity and ending the term with positive gender relationships. Throughout this unit students will work collaboratively to develop a deeper understanding of gender norms and the difference between equity and equality.

#### Homework

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Reminder that year 5's have a minimum of 20 minutes reading each night for homework, along with completing any unfinished work from the week.

### Reading

Making Connections/Inferencing: In your child's take-home-reader, ask them the take down note of text to self connections, text to world connections and text to text connections.

Searching & Using Information: Help your child choose a topic to research such as . What is the key information?

**Critiquing:** Collect different products from around the house and review them.

### Numeracy

Length, mass and capacity: measure different items throughout the house. Allowing students to help with the cooking.

**Time:** Students can plan a family holiday. Practice reading time both digital and analog.


**Location:** Draw a map of the house. Ask you child to gibe you direction to somewhere, this could be a shop, park or favourite place.

### Writing

Narratives: To help your child with their narrative writing, encourage them to write short stories at home and read them out loud to you.

**Procedural:** Ask your child to write out the instructions for how to complete a task e.g) making a sandwich, kicking a ball, drawing a dog etc. Follow their instructions. Can you do it?

**Reviews:** Help your child access different review platforms like websites and magazines, ask: Is this a good product? Why/why not?
