Itineray

Should include visiting Rome for 3 nights, including the Coliseum, Gallery Borghese, and a Vatican City Tour. An overnight visit to Sienna, then the hilltop town of San Gimignano. 5 nights in Florence with guided tours of the Uffizi and Academia Galleries along with a street art walk. 1 night in Bologna to see the Pinacoteca Nazionale and the MAMBO of Contemporary Art followed by a tour of the Carpigiani Gelato factory. Finally, 3 nights exploring Venice, visiting the Guggenheim Museum, Ca Pessaro, and Doge's Palace

Gallery Tours

Guided tours of the major galleries in each of the cities and towns visited.
