#### Who may nominate?

Nominations should be endorsed by the school's principal. In the event of the principal being nominated or making a nomination, the endorsement of the deputy principal should be obtained.

## Spirit of Catholic Education Awards 2022

### Judging and Presentation of Awards

The judging panel will review all nominations and short list nominees on the basis of their outstanding contribution to Catholic education in one or more of the following areas:

#### Inspiring Faith

This seeks to identify persons who have made a significant contribution to the development of students' faith lives. It may include exemplary work in Religious Education, parish involvement, the school's spiritual life, social justice or day-to-day exemplification of Gospel values.

#### Inspiring Learning

This seeks to identify persons who have made a significant contribution to student learning. It may include exemplary classroom and specialist teaching. Nominees should demonstrate a clear commitment to contemporary pedagogy.

While it is likely that nominees will demonstrate strengths across more than one area, we ask you to identify the one that best reflects their contribution.

The panel will select up to six individuals to receive the awards.

Awards will be presented at the annual Diocese of Sale Leadership Eucharist and Dinner on Friday 27 May 2022, subject to COVID-19 restrictions.
