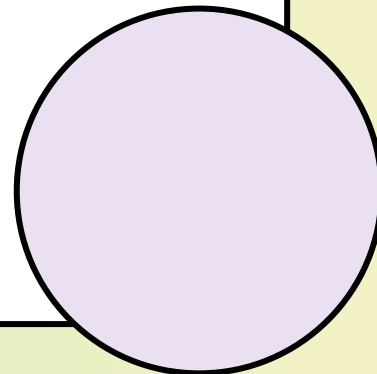
Acknowledgement of Country

We make this statement believing that we can walk together to a better future because Newlands Primary School commits itself to Reconciliation.

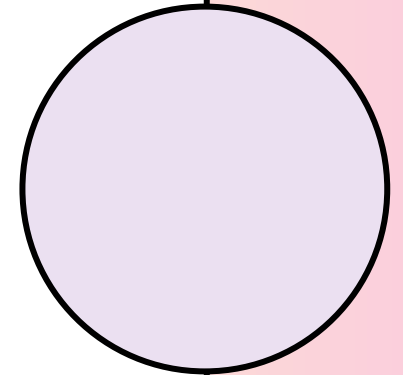

- During the last week of every Term we celebrate a Spanish speaking country by exploring significant cultural events/activities.

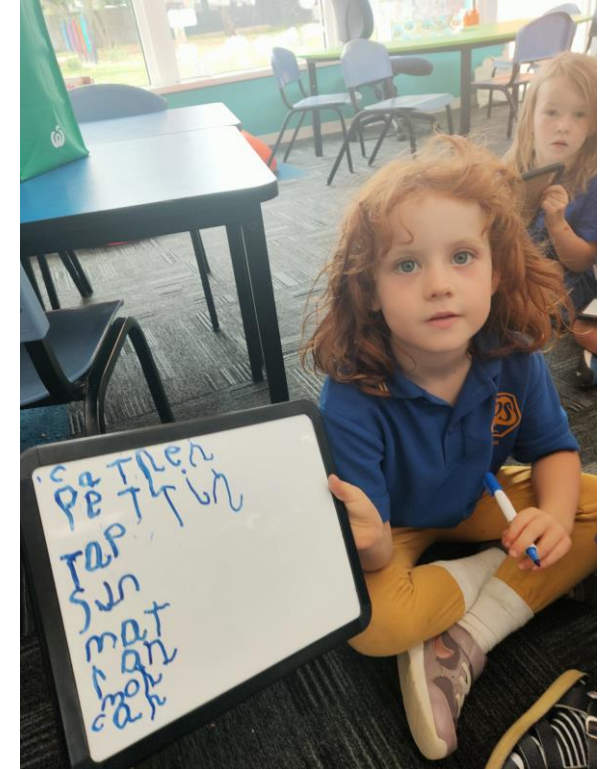
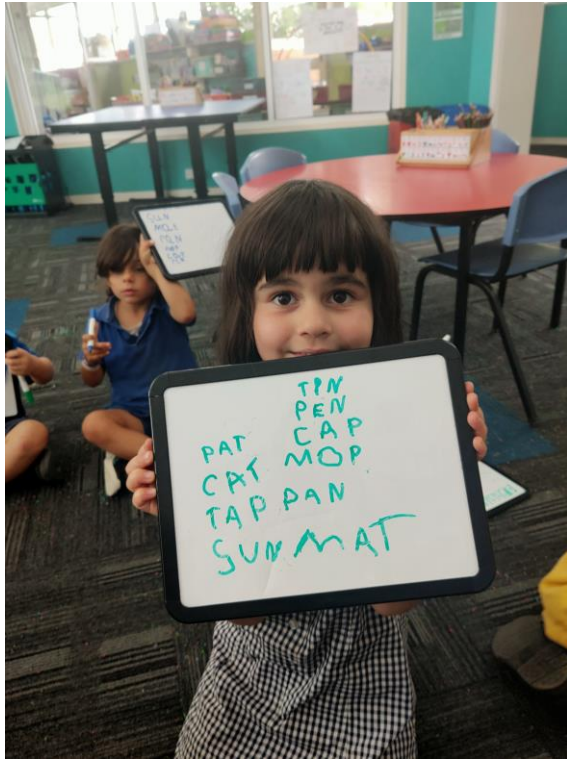
