

Home Activity

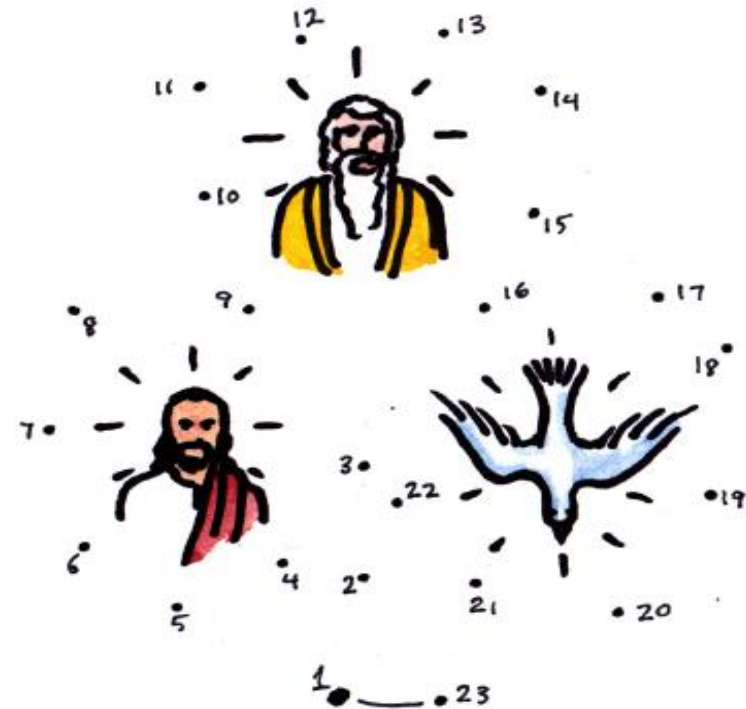
For parents: The Solemnity of the Holy Trinity invites us to remember that God has revealed himself to us as one God in three Persons. As Jesus departed from his disciples, he shared with them the power to make disciples of all nations. He taught his disciples to invite others to share in the life of the blessed Trinity by sharing with others the gift of Baptism. This continues to be the mission of the Church. Each of us who has been baptised shares in the life of the blessed Trinity and also shares in the Church's mission of inviting others to share in God's love.

- **As you gather as a family, bring out pictures and other mementos of family celebrations of the Sacrament of Baptism.**
- **Talk about the significance of Baptism with your family.**
- **Read together today's Gospel, Matthew 28:16-20.**
- **Notice that Jesus taught his disciples to baptise all nations in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.**
- **What else does this remind you of? (the Sign of the Cross)**
- **Recall that whenever we pray the Sign of the Cross, we are reminding ourselves that we are united with God through our Baptism and share in the life of the blessed Trinity.**
- **Pray together the Glory Be to the Father.**

and life everlasting. Amen

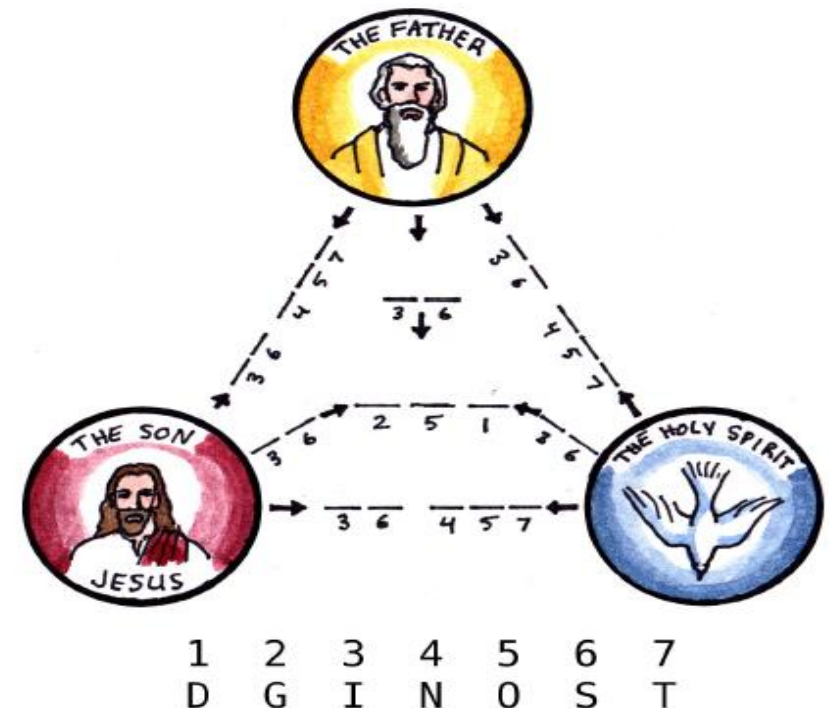
Blessed Trinity Puzzle

What is the Blessed Trinity?

The Blessed Trinity is God! There are three Persons in God, but there is only one God. "Trinity" comes from the Latin word for three.

Only God the Son, Who is Jesus, has a body. But we show God the Father as an old man, and the Holy Spirit as a dove.

GOD, THE HOLY TRINITY



Jesus taught us that God is not just one Person, but three Persons in one God. The three Persons in God are God the Father, God the Son Who is Jesus, and God the Holy Spirit.

The three Persons in God know each other perfectly and all want the exact same thing. The Blessed Trinity is a mystery that we can't really understand. It is the three Persons of God loving each other so much we could never even measure or understand it! And God, the Blessed Trinity, decided to create us so that we could adore them and join in their love! That's what Heaven is: being with the Blessed Trinity in total happiness forever!
