# Encouraging faith at home

Our primary goal as followers of Jesus is that everyone should know who their heavenly Father is and that He wishes to have an intimate and purpose-filled relationship with each and every one of His precious children.

This relationship is deepened when we:

- live as disciples of Jesus Christ at home, in the workplace, in the community and the world
- develop an understanding of the Bible and our faith tradition
- deepen our spiritual life and practices, and engage in service and mission
- relate the Christian faith to life today
- participate in the life and ministries of our faith communities.



The Four Keys of Caring Conversations, Devotions, Service, Rituals and Traditions provide some ideas that can assist us. Christian values and faith are passed on to the next generation when they are seen in action. Faith becomes real when others can see God working in the lives of people.



#### Caring Conversations



- In your conversations, listen closely to the important issues, core values, passions, faith and doubts expressed. It's important that we provide space to ask questions. Respond to concerns compassionately, showing God's love and understanding.
- Pray together bring God into the conversation.
- Support and encourage the gifts you see in one another.
- Discuss how to use resources wisely, faithfully and joyfully.
- Be intentional and initiate conversations about the way you spend your time, money and how you can allow God into every part of your life and seek His guidance and instruction.
- Share your story with each other hearing faith stories is one of the most important influences on our faith.

## Devotions — II

Our faith shapes the whole of our lives and involves a lifetime of Bible study, reflection and prayer.

- Pray at all times.
- Instead of feeding the insatiable quest for more news and social networking, consider beginning and/or ending the day reading, praying or meditating on Scripture.
- Family devotions provide a way to learn more about the Bible and Christian tradition as a family.
- Encourage each other to apply these teachings to daily life.
- Share a 'God moment' from your day, a time when you have been keenly aware of God's presence and interaction in your life.



Serving others together provides an opportunity to see people's gifts, faith and values in action. Service is the day-in and day-out lifestyle we lead that demonstrates the faith in us. Families can engage in this key every day.

- Do simple things that show God's love in the world. Open the door for someone, give up your seat, and smile!
- Both children and adults are more likely to have a growing, strong faith when their family serves others together.
- Find a charity, locally, nationally or internationally that you can assist.
  Get involved in a service event in your community!





# Rituals and Traditions

Rituals and traditions communicate meaning, values and relationships that exist between people and with God. Rituals and traditions are those patterns of behaviour that occur with regularity.

- Family rituals can take many forms, from daily rituals such as mealtime, bedtime, leaving and returning, to celebrations such as birthdays, anniversaries, and special achievements.
- Celebrate church year rituals at home, such as Advent and Lent.
- Recognise milestones such as first days of school and graduations, etc.
- Bless people when they arrive and when they leave your home.
- Have symbols in your home that express your faith.
