

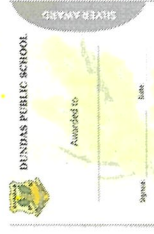
Dundas Public School Awards

Bronze Award



Students receive bronze awards for displaying our school values of being a Safe, Respectful and Successful Learner. Examples include academic achievement or exemplary effort in specific curriculum areas, sportsmanship and cooperation. Bronze awards

Silver Award



When a student achieves 5 Bronze Awards, they should be handed to their classroom teacher, who will award them with a Silver Award. Silver Awards are handed out during Stage assemblies.

Gold Award

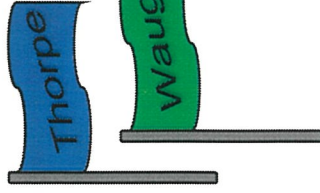

Wattle Award

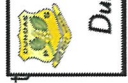

Dundas Tokens
