

Year 7 Scholarships in 2022

Mount Clear College is very pleased to offer scholarships to the incoming Year 7 students for 2022.

The 12 month scholarship will include payment of the Year 7 Essential Student Learning items (student fees) for 2022. In addition, an amount of \$200 will be credited to the student's school account and will be available to support the student's involvement in the area in which the scholarship is awarded (eg. books, music tuition, BAS competition fees).

The criteria under which the scholarships will be awarded are:

Scholarship category	Requirements
Academic	High academic achievement, participation and success in extra-curricular activities and demonstration of citizenship.
Sporting	Sporting achievement, participation and success in extra-curricular activities and demonstration of citizenship
Music/Art	Artistic achievement, a commitment to participate in ensembles/performance/exhibitions, participation and success in extra curricula activities and demonstration of citizenship
Leadership	Positive leadership & citizenship contributions to the community and demonstration of the values of Mount Clear College.

Section 8 of this Application requires students to provide the contact details of their Grade 6 Teacher or their Primary School Principal, who will be contacted as a referee. This section also requires the authorisation of the student's Parent/Guardian for our College to contact this referee.

Students who are short listed will be requested to attend an interview and they will be required to bring a portfolio of their best work. Interviews will be conducted.
