How to Book

At the designated interview time, parents access the link on the Sentral Portal and will then be admitted into a waiting room and the teacher will be notified that you have 'arrived'.

The meeting will commence once the Teacher grants permission for entry. Please note, the interviews will be allocated 5 minutes of time. The additional 2 minutes will allow time for parents and teachers to navigate to the next Teams meeting.
