

2020 Parent Payment Charges

Dear Parents

Fitzroy Primary School has a system of combined payment for books/stationery and other essential supplies for students. The school purchases the required books and stationery at a bulk discount price to ensure maximum value for your money and provides all students with the same quality brands as their classmates.

Essential Standard Learning Items for students are a critical part of the school budget. Your payment for curriculum supplies enables us to provide the additional resources that enrich the education of your child. This includes:

Note: Parents may choose to provide or purchase some items themselves. If you choose to do this you must consult with the school so that your child has the right items. There may be some items or services you cannot purchase yourself.

The combined Essential Standard Learning Items cost for 2020 is \$230.00 per student. Subsidies will be available to eligible families, as described below.

School Council has approved a subsidy of \$100 per eligible student towards the combined Essential Standard Learning Items costs for families with a valid Health care/Centrelink card. This means that *eligible families will only need to pay \$130.00 per student* for Essential Standard Learning items.

Optional Items

During the year, there will be a variety of camps, swimming, sport and excursion/incursions offered to all students. Each of these will have its own costs. If you hold a current health Care/Centrelink card you may be eligible to draw on the CSEF funds that have also been provided to the school for this purpose.

School uniform can be purchased from the Uniform Shop. Uniform costs cannot be covered by the CSEF.
