Entries close Wednesday 3 April before 1pm with Entry Fee and signed Entry Form

Exhibition shall be open from Friday 5 to Saturday 4 May (approx. one month)

Official Opening Friday 5 April (Competition open to RTG Members and the general public)

OFFICIAL EXHIBITION OPENING Friday 5 April 4pm with winners announced at 5pm - join us for refreshments at the Opening (please RSVP). **People's Choice** to be announced near the end of the Exhibition, being Friday 3 May @ 12N (therefore giving people the opportunity to cast their one vote overall). Exhibition to be on display at the RTG from Friday 5 April to Saturday 4 May during normal opening hours. Collection of works after **Friday 10 May** from the RTG during normal opening hours – to be collected by Friday 17 May at the latest please.

CATEGORIES/PRIZES – \$2,405 CASH (plus framing vouchers). **BEST LOCAL SCENE** (50km from Edenhope) which is applicable in category **A PAINTING** only (\$350 donation by Andrew Farran).

- A PAINTING (2D):** Adult 1st \$300; Secondary 1st \$50; 2nd \$20; 3rd \$10; Primary 1st \$25 plus \$20 framing voucher; 2nd \$15; 3rd \$10. *Painting (2D) artwork refers to flat artwork (not photography) which shall be ready to be hung in adult's section; and junior entries welcomed unframed (may be blutak to walls). See T&Cs.*
- B PHOTOGRAPHY:** Adult \$300. Secondary \$50 plus \$25 framing voucher : Primary \$25 - laminated photographs will NOT be accepted and student entries shall be backed onto lightweight black board to be either blu-tak or pinned.
- C OTHER (3D):** Adult \$300; Secondary \$25 plus \$40 framing voucher; Primary \$25. This category refers to other art or anything sticking out, sculptures, woodwork, metalwork etc. Entries to have a base no larger than 800mm x 800mm, stable with support supplied as needed, and easily lifted by 2 people. This category may be applicable to mixed media/digital art.

PEOPLE'S CHOICE: \$400 only one overall winner (one vote only) donated by Andrew Farran. Anyone who puts in a People's Choice vote may write their name and contact number as well to be eligible to enter the Secret Raffle (to be announced Friday 3 May 12N).

CHAMPION OF SHOW – The Judge will choose CHAMPION OF SHOW (applicable in any category) – the best piece to win \$500 (this entry is not eligible for the 1st prize).

All students shall receive a Participation Certificate. Framing vouchers donated by Bull's Rustic Wood'n'Frames.

DATES FOR YOUR CALENDAR - Entry form and artwork due by **Wed 3 April to the Red Tail Gallery before 1pm**, but may be delivered earlier (please note that the RTG is open Wed-Fri 10am to 1pm; and Sat 10am to 12N – of course this will depend on volunteer availability), please bring sufficient wrapping (labelled if you would like it returned). Judging to occur before Official Opening and the decision of the judge/s is final.

TERMS & CONDITIONS –

Entries must be your own unaided work and must be accompanied with appropriate entry fee (for each adult entry).

All entries must be recorded into a RTG Register and signed when picked up.

Limit of 3 entries only (on same form) for Adults (with only one piece being 'large') – Secondary and Primary may only enter one (1) piece (limited to A4).

Only artwork created after approx **1 September 2022** may be entered (that is approximately 18 months).

This RTG Art Competition is **NOT THEMED**. Under Category **A PAINTING** – your piece of art may be applicable for the BEST LOCAL SCENE (local scene may be depicted as a landscape, building, animal – anything within 50km of Edenhope) – please ensure you tick the box/s in the entry form – if the scene is unidentified, you may be asked for the location.

All art medium welcomed for the different categories, including (but not limited to) painting, drawing, printmaking, sculpture, mixed art medium, woodwork, metalwork, quilting, paper and photography.

All smudgeable material must be adequately fixed with fixing spray.

Please write your name and contact details on the back of your work. Your artwork must be signed in and signed out.

While all care is taken, exhibitors are reminded that the RTG, the RTG Committee or it's volunteers do not take responsibility for loss or damage to works. Insurance of your work is the entrant's responsibility.

Should your artwork not be deemed appropriate for the RTG Art Competition, you will be notified via phone or email immediately by one of the committee members and your entry fee will be refunded to you.

Artists will be responsible for all arrangements and costs associated with packing, freight, insurance (both in transit and whilst on display) and transporting of the artwork to and from Edenhope.

Please ensure that all packaging is clearly labelled and suitable for re-use to ensure safe return of the artwork.

The RTG retain the rights to have any entry photographed, with these photographs to be reproduced in the press or other media for the purpose of publicity of this and any future art show. The RTG will not use the photographs of any artwork for reproduction with the purpose of sales of the reproduced image for profit. The copyright of the artwork remain solely in the possession of the submitting artist. The RTG does not permit visitors to the Gallery to take photographs of your artwork.

Collection of artwork from other towns – Meagan Lonsdale 03 5585 1231 has offered to collect art from Casterton at Gorman's Art Gallery (open Thur-Sat) – please leave at **Casterton the week 17-24 March**; also will collect from Naracoorte Art Gallery please leave at **COB Wednesday 17 March**. Please contact Meagan to arrange. At this stage, Meagan will return to Casterton after the event, and Naracoorte is approximately 22 May.

SALE OF ARTWORK All artwork is encouraged to be for sale. Artist must provide an all inclusive sale price on the entry form if the artwork is to be available for sale and the RTG will retain 20% commission. In the event of a sale, the RTG shall forward sale proceeds to the artist within a reasonable timeframe.

ENTRIES BY SCHOOL AGED STUDENTS – it is the wish of the RTG that INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES be received from interested school-aged children who wish to submit competition entries. Please note that when hanging the school-aged entries that all Primary aged entries will be grouped under the umbrella of 'Primary' and Secondary aged entries will be grouped under the umbrella of 'Secondary' – the entries will not be segregated into year level categories. Please note that the RTG offers its facilities (at no charge) to the Edenhope & Goroke Kindergarten to display their works as well as St. Malachy's Primary School and Edenhope College – giving these schools the chance to showcase their artwork every year.

DOGGY CORNER – supporting 'The Day of the Dackel' event weekend Sunday 7 April. If you would like to display your doggy art at the Red Tail Gallery. Doggy art may be left at the RTG from Wed 3 April or at the latest Fri 5 April. We will happily display doggy art from RTG members and others.
