

COVID-19 Sport Safety



Introduction

St Peters Lutheran College has a responsibility to provide a safe environment for its workforce, volunteers and visitors. We will adhere to the current Government Public Health orders and follow the Return to Play Guidelines.

Health Hygiene



The following behaviours must be observed:

- Wash hands regularly with soap and water (where possible), including before and after training and games and especially after visiting the bathroom.
- Use alcohol-base hand sanitiser. We encourage all members of the community to bring their own sanitiser if they can.
- Sanitation stations will be provided at entry and exit points at venues where hand washing facilities are not readily available.



- Practice good cough etiquette cover coughs and sneezes with your elbow or a tissue.
- Put used tissues straight into the bin.
- Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth.
- Students to arrive in playing uniform as change rooms will not be accessible.
- Students are not to share water bottles, towels or other personal items.

Physical Distancing



- Follow social distancing rules keep 1.5m away from other people where reasonably practicable
- Avoid handshaking, high-fiving, team huddles or hugging – instead give three cheers.
- The flow of spectators and non-essential personnel will be managed within the venue.



- Floor markings will be in place to maintain social distancing requirements.
- Parents/Carers to stop, drop and go or wait in their car if not permitted into the venue.

Facilities and Equipment



- Separate entry and exit points, closed areas, restricted access areas and separate participation areas will be created to minimise contact and maintain the required physical distancing.
- Signage will clearly state restricted areas, entry, exit and directional flow.
- Regular cleaning protocols have been established at all venues around the College.
- Training equipment and surfaces will be cleaned before each use and immediately after each session.
- Limited equipment sharing across groups, no sharing of personal equipment.
- Communal facilities such as change-rooms, showers will be closed.

Keeping People Healthy







- Signing up to the COVID Safe App will be promoted and strongly encouraged.
- It is vitally important, that any member of our community (students, staff, coaches, officials, visitors) who is unwell (even with the mildest symptoms) does not come to the College grounds.
- Signs will be placed at entry points to instruct participants and visitors not to enter if they are unwell.
- If a student presents as unwell a parent/caregiver will need to collect their child immediately.

Communications and Stakeholder Engagement

- A COVID Safe Officer will be present at each event.
- Staff and volunteers (coaches, officials, sports medicine, administrative staff) will be informed and trained about the conditions / restrictions of sport at St Peters.
- Participants, parents/carers will be informed about the conditions / restrictions of sport at St Peters.
- Visiting schools will be emailed weekly regarding processes around sport safety, venue plans and logistical timing requirements.
- Attendance registers will be provided at each venue for completion on entry and exit.








