Dear Parent/Guardian

Mobile Dental Services will be visiting your child's school and scheduling a bulk billed dental clinic for eligible children under the CDBS. To be eligible for dental treatment you need to be receiving a payment from the Australian Government.

Mobile Dental Services will check eligibility and advise parents who are unsure if they are able to have their child's treatment bulk billed through Medicare. If your child is not eligible, we are still happy to provide treatments in accordance to Medicare pricings.

Our dental team will provide access to the following dental services during school hours:

- Comprehensive Oral Examination with Treatment care plans.
- Scaling/cleaning and fluoride treatments.
- Fillings.
- Fissure sealants.
- Extractions.

Your child will be issued with a treatment plan after their initial visit to our mobile dental van which will outline all treatment required along with Medicare pricing.

In due course, the team will then proceed with the treatment that was outlined in the plan sent home.

Your child will receive quality dental treatment from our dental team, all of whom are working with children certified.

In order for your child to be seen by our oral health professionals, you must complete and return the consent and medical history forms to the school/centre signed by a parent or guardian. Mobile Dental Services cannot see your child if the consent forms have not been filled out correctly.

Checklist:

1. Carefully read the attached consent forms.
2. Complete all the relevant sections on the forms.
3. Return to the school by the due date.

Child Dental Benefits Schedule

The Child Dental Benefit Schedule (CDBS) provides basic dental services to children. Dental services are capped at \$1,013 over 2 consecutive calendar years.

Dental services include:

- Examinations
- X rays
- Cleaning
- Fissure sealants
- Fillings
- Extractions

The CDBS does not cover orthodontic or cosmetic dental work.

To be eligible for the Child Dental Benefit Schedule, your child must:

- be aged 2 to 17 years for at least 1 day of the calendar year.
- be eligible for Medicare
- receive, or be part of a family receiving, certain Australian Government payments.

Medicare will assess eligibility at the beginning of each calendar year and it's valid for the entire year. Children who become eligible later in the calendar year will have their eligibility backdated to begin from 1 January of that calendar year.

If you do not use all your \$1,000 benefit in the first year of eligibility, you can use it in the second year if you are still eligible. Any remaining balance will not be carried forward at the end of the second year.

Child Dental Benefits Schedule Services will not count towards the Medicare Safety Net or the Extended Medicare Safety Net thresholds.

CHILD DENTAL BENEFITS SCHEDULE BULK BILLING PATIENT CONSENT FORM.

I, the patient/legal guardian certify that I have been informed:

- Of the treatment that has been or will be provided from this date under the Child Dental Benefits Schedule.
- Of the likely cost of this treatment; and
- That I will be bulk billed for services under the Child Dental Benefits Schedule and I will not pay out-of-pocket costs for these services, subject to sufficient funds being available under the benefit cap.

I understand that/I the patient will only have access to dental benefits of up to the benefit cap.

I understand that the benefits for some services may have restrictions and that the Child Dental Benefits Schedule covers a limited range of services, I understand I will need to personally meet the cost of any services not covered by the Child Dental Benefits Schedule. I understand that the cost of services will reduce the available benefit cap and that I will need to personally meet the costs of any additional services once benefits are exhausted.

Mobile Dental Services is happy to visit your school/childcare this year.

Due to the current situation, we have integrated strict screening policies and hygiene protocols to help ensure the health and safety of staff and children.

We want to assure that the safety of children and staff are of top priority. Our goals are to help mitigate any spread of Covid throughout the community.

Prior to entry into van following steps will be undertaken:

- **Hand sanitizer is provided upon entry along with standard dentistry P.P.E. for patients.**
- **Body temperature may be taken before entering the van.**
- **Procedures may be slightly altered to minimise aerosols.**
- **Toys have been removed from the dental van.**
- **We will be having only one child at a time for the treatment and more extensive disinfection is performed between patients.**
