Reason the product is recalled:

The product is being recalled because the gel packs may contain ethylene glycol, a toxic substance.

The hazards to consumers:

If packaging becomes damaged, ethylene glycol can leak out. If swallowed, ethylene glycol can cause irreversible injuries or death.

What consumers should do:

1. Stop using the Gel Pak immediately and keep out of reach of children.
2. Return the product to a Kmart store for a full refund.
