Eligible families can access up to \$200 per as part of the Get Active Victoria Kids Voucher program.

To be eligible, kids need to be aged 0 to 18, a Victorian resident, named on a valid Commonwealth Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card and named on a valid Medicare Card at the time of application.

The concession covers things like:

- ✓ Sport membership, registration or general fees to participate at an affiliated sport or active recreation club, association or program.
- ✓ Uniforms: club issued t-shirt, shorts, socks, soccer boots, runners
- ✓ Required equipment: shin guards, mouth guards, goalkeeper gloves, sunscreen
