
we've done this year as a community. And don't worry, for those of you still planning your holidays and trying to figure out what to buy your loved ones for Christmas, we've got some ideas for you!

- Game night (board games, video games bonus points for a whole game show set up w/ dedicated host)


### Alone (no money required)
