

# VAPING AND SMOKING POLICY

#### Context

Smoking, vaping, using e-cigarettes or possession of smoking or vaping paraphernalia is prohibited by the Department of Education on or near the school site or while attending school-based excursions and activities external to the school.

## **Processes and expectations**

Students and Parents	Teachers	Head Teachers
<ul> <li>Are not to bring smoking / vaping paraphernalia to school including tobacco, vape liquids, lighters, filters, vapes, cigarettes, etc.</li> <li>Parents work with the school to support the policy and expectations and to provide education.</li> <li>Parents concerned that their child is using vapes at school, please contact the school. If they have concerns for their child's health, please speak to the family paediatrician or doctor.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Report incidents related to the Vaping and Smoking Policy to the Deputy Principal via Sentral and in person.         Teachers may request for the vape from a student. If the student declines do not continue to engage.</li> <li>Report incidents via Sentral of students who arrive to class late smelling of smoke or vape or where vape vapour has been seen.</li> <li>Do not allow students out of class with school bags to use bathrooms or without a permission note or PBL pass.</li> </ul>	Support teachers when following up students who have engaged in behaviour contrary to this procedure.

### **Senior Executive**

- Due to the immediate and/or significant risk of harm to students or staff, any student in
  possession of smoking / vaping paraphernalia, caught vaping or smoking or supplying smoking
  / vaping paraphernalia will be immediately placed on a suspension from school.
- Bag searches will be conducted of students suspected of concealing vaping or smoking paraphernalia.
- Parents will be contacted for any smoking or vaping related incidents.
- Students who are found to be selling vaping or smoking paraphernalia will be reported to NSW Health.
- Students caught vaping, smoking or selling paraphernalia will be referred to the Francis Greenway High School wellbeing team for education and support.
