Dear Parents/Carers

As part of our Sport program this term, Years 5 and 6 will be attending various sports off school grounds. This program will run for five consecutive weeks from 9 November to 7 December. This year all of Year 5 & 6 will rotate through the different activities available. This gives an opportunity for everyone to participate in a variety of fun sporting activities with their friends. The College will cover all costs and no additional payment is required.

Please note that as we need to leave school early for sport, Years 5 & 6 will have an early lunch on sports days. For this reason we have decided that it is too difficult and time consuming to open the canteen during their usual preparation time. We ask that you send a packed lunch for your students on out of school sports days. However, for both fishing and the beach a BBQ lunch will be provided free of charge. On these weeks, no lunch is required.

Fishing

- The College will provide some rods, all bait and sunscreen. Students are encouraged to bring their own rod from home if feasible with transport
- Those not wishing to try fishing will be able to participate in some fun activities with a teacher along the foreshore
- Students should wear full sports uniform including a hat and bring a water bottle
- A sausage sizzle will be provided free of charge for those attending fishing

Indoor Sports Centre & Inflatable World

- Students will play a variety of sports at the centre in Taree
- · Students should wear full sports uniform including quality sports shoes and bring a full water bottle

Swimming & Beach!

- A supervised free swim will be at the YMCA in Weeks 6 or 7 and the Bullring at Forster Main Beach on our beach day in Week 8
- Students will have an opportunity to change before leaving school. They may wear swimmers underneath their usual sports uniform or change at school
- Students should also come to school with a towel, clean underclothes and a plastic bag to store wet gear. Students should bring a hat and water bottle. The College will provide sunscreen
- Girls are required to wear one piece swimmers in accordance with College Policy. Two piece swimmers with a rash shirt over the top is also acceptable
